4-Year Honours: Adds '(Hons.)' to the degree title, signalling full programme completion with enhanced depth courses and a dissertation/capstone (160 credits).

4-Year Honours with Research: Adds '(Hons. with Research)' — awarded when the student completes a structured research component in Semesters 7–8 (typically 12–16 additional credits, total ~176 credits).

Specialization placement: Across all three levels, the specialization remains in parentheses on the degree certificate/transcript per UGC CCFUP guidelines. The degree title itself carries only the standardized academic discipline name.

NOTE:

[I] Student who EXIT for ‘Certificate’ will have to complete 4 Credit Internship Programme in Summer Vacation.

[II] Students who want to EXIT from ‘Diploma’(Level 5.5) will have to complete 4 Credit Internship Programme in Summer Vacation.

Admission Process:

To maintain the highest quality of instruction across all faculties, the College is strictly committed to abiding by the following educational standards and instructional guidelines for the grant of a first degree through formal education, in accordance with the **UGC Regulations, 2003**.

1. Eligibility and Admission Criteria

- **Basic Eligibility:** No student shall be eligible for admission to a first-degree program in any faculty unless they have successfully passed the examination conducted by a recognized School Board at the +2 level (or equivalent) and cleared the competitive merit threshold.
- **Merit-Based Selection:** Admissions shall be granted based on competitive merit (average of 12th + CET marks) according to the criteria notified by College guidelines. These selections will continuously align with the norms issued by the UGC and other statutory bodies.
- **Resource-Linked Enrollment:** Student enrollment shall strictly correspond to the available academic and physical infrastructure, adhering to prescribed student-teacher ratios, teaching-to-non-teaching staff ratios, and laboratory/library capacities.

2. Lateral Entry and Direct Admissions

The College permits lateral entry to a specified number of students directly into the second year of a program, provided the student meets either of the following conditions:

- **Option A:** Successfully completed the first year of the exact same program and having the required number of credits from any recognized institution.

- **Option B:** Already holds a successfully completed first degree and demonstrates the academic capacity and desire to pursue another first degree in an allied subject or discipline.

Discipline and Student Responsibilities On and Off Campus

- i. Students are required to attend all lectures, practicals, and academic activities as per the prescribed timetable. Unauthorized absence shall be treated as indiscipline and may attract penalties or disciplinary action as per institutional norms.
- ii. Smoking, chewing tobacco, consumption of intoxicants, possession or viewing of objectionable material, and the use of prohibited electronic devices such as cameras or unauthorized audio equipment within the college premises are strictly prohibited. Violations shall be dealt with in accordance with the College rules.
- iii. Students shall not engage in promotional or marketing activities related to private coaching classes within or outside the campus. Any violation may result in disciplinary action.
- iv. A student remaining continuously absent for one month without prior permission or valid justification may have his/her admission cancelled and may become ineligible for scholarships and institutional facilities.
- v. Parents/guardians desirous of obtaining information regarding the academic progress or conduct of their ward may visit the College and meet the concerned department authorities. Parents are requested to record their visit in the designated Visitor's Register.
- vi. Students participating in educational tours, excursions, or field visits must submit an undertaking as prescribed by the Excursion Committee. Participation shall be at the student's own responsibility, and adherence to all rules and guidelines is mandatory.
- vii. Students using two-wheelers for transportation must wear helmets compulsorily while entering the campus. Entry of four-wheel vehicles by students into the college premises is not permitted.
- viii. Students shall communicate any absence from classes to the concerned Head of the Department through the official email or digital communication platform provided by the College.
- ix. Any change in a student's residential address, email address, or mobile number must be promptly communicated to the College Office and the concerned Head of the Department to ensure effective communication.
- x. Students must immediately report any damage to college property, including furniture, laboratory equipment, computers, fans, or other infrastructure, to the College Office or the Principal. Failure to report such damage may result in recovery of the cost from the concerned student, batch, or class.
